

Our Services


Our activities are carried out by trainined professionals who are empathetic and passionate about supporting others and engaging in community service, having a sence of community well being and development.

About the Founder



Health and Wellbeing Awareness

Joyce O. Community organised virtual workshops on health and well-being. The programmes were held on the 3rd of April, 2021 and the 28th of August, 2021. Both events were facilitator-led and streamed across many social media platforms. Topics discussed ranged from Mental Wellbeing, Nutrition Needs and Special Education Needs (SEN). There was an impressive turnout of participants who asked salient questions related to the after-effects of the pandemic and shared their perspectives. Youth Engagement Seminar

The seminar focused on empowering young people with skills and motivating them to embrace learning and take advantage of the available training opportunities. The event featured professional educators, including Cllr Yetunde Adeshina, Founder of Next Chosen Generation CIC; Ugie Erhabor, Founder of RUZEN Education; and Irene Eribo, CEO of Ebony Ambassadors, to mention a few.

The Youth Engagement Seminar enhanced knowledge and skills, creating avenues for Independence for young people to gain skills for life and employability skills. Discussion highlights included crucial factors to bridging the poverty gap and developing a sense of purpose, direction and decision making leading to their Independence.
